

DATAROCK

is a trio formed summer 2000 in the Norwegian west coast town Bergen. The 3 members; Ketil, Fredrik and Tom, have all different background in the local Bergen scene (well, at least Fredrik and Ketil have, Tom is basically a computer guy), playing in everything from punk bands to jazz quartets.

Since the three boys have such different musical references, the "Datarock sound" will contain everything from cheesy pop to lo-fi rock and house music, all of it created in rather primitive recording facilities.

Allthough the group has been around for quite a short time, they have already managed to get a reputation as one of the most exiting new liveacts in Norway. Their performances might feature low-budget multimedia and/or guest appearances from other artists. (I.e. their stunning concerts with their 7-piece men's choir)

Datarock have also got a decent amount of airplay on national radio, plus features in different magazines and papers. The trio have recently toured Norway supporting finnish electronica nutters Op:l Bastards, as well as supported Kitty-Yo star Peaches at the NuMusic Festival i Stavanger.

Their first release, a split 10" EP (with Stockhaus) is out now on Ellet Records.
